

Assuming your alerts used to work, and are setup correctly to have sounds play: Check under OBS/Settings/Audio/Advanced and ensure the monitoring device is set correctly. Also check Edit/Advanced Audio Properties and ensure the 'AlertBox' source is setup correctly for audio monitoring. Lastly, you could also right click the speaker icon in the system tray and select 'Open Sound Settings'. Scroll down to advanced sound options and select App volume and device preferences. Here you can route all of the OBS application sounds to a specific audio output device.You should be able to go to the Streamlabs website and click the test alert buttons as much as you want until you can get the sounds routed correctly. I am having the same issue, i set up obs to control the volume, otherwise with my setup, it wouldnt play on stream, but now i cant hear it... Ok ive managed to fix the issue, now when i press "test notification" it works, i can hear it, but when someone actually follows me, i cannot see or hear the notification... Maybe its the same Problem i have... Pleas try to open the Windows Audio Controlpanel and close it again.After that my Sound works as usual. Can anyl confirm this?(i have different sound devices for everything... Mic, Game, TS/Disord, Alerts , Music...) I'm having the same issue. Everything is set to my iFi da/camp combo. I had zero issues until then. I'm still having these issues today. Even under my sound settings in windows, my output sound is set directly to OBS to use only that channel. It still reverts to my stereo speakers instead of the selected output. Did anyone ever find a fix for this? I use wavelink and after updating, sound alerts come across stream but not through my headset. im having this issue aswell. my chat can hear but i cant hear anything at all Yeah i am having the same issue. I want to control Sound Alerts audio through OBS . My chat can hear it but I cant hear anything. Ok. I had almost the same issue here, tried a mess of stuff 'til I went to the stupid-check and voila.. there was my problem. It was without mistake a classic case of PEBCAK (Problem Exists Between Chair And Keyboard), which also reminded me never to toggle on something after I am in the morning. Brief description of my problem: I was updating and adding new stuff to my obs layouts, and for some reasons I could hear the sound of my video emotes but could not see them. Even by copying the alert url on a blank page, it wouldn't show. Fun thing is that all other pages displayed the alerts properly, just this one not. Today I re-re-re-checked all and noticed a little something which made me feel an idiot (much more than I am or usually feel): when I started to stream and built my pages, I decided to separate my layouts into multiple ones, so that I could display some things instead of others according to the page/mood/content. Simply put, I had copied the wrong layout on the page. Once I corrected that little snafu, everything worked just as it was supposed to be. So to prevent anyone else from sobbing on the keyboard for your own bad attention, double check that the page you want something to be displayed into has all the needed layers.Have fun streaming everyone, hope this helped! => Literally created an account just to thank you, after weeks of on and off searching I decided to google the problem one last time before I just gave up on it and came across this comment. I use like Aifemka, VoiceMeeter Potato for the sound I hear personally, and I use OBS to control ALL the sounds that are heard on the stream (Game output, spotify, discord, ...) to differentiate both (sound I hear and sound coming out on the stream).However, in vain I check "Monitoring and Output" in the advanced audio properties of my "Alerts" sound, I still do not hear the alerts ... And yet they can be heard during a recording or a stream ... I have correctly configured my "Loudspeakers (headphones)" as "Audio Monitoring device". Anyone know where the problem is coming from? I tried unchecking Enable Browser Source Hardware Acceleration as this helped before but that also hasn't fixed it this time around. I checked to make sure the link was correct and I'm logged into Twitch and Streamlabs. I can get it to show when I open the twitch box url on another tab but for some reason OBS is just refusing to display it. It's just an invisible box on OBS. Any advice on how to fix this? Had the same exact issue were my streamlabs chatbox link is not showing twitch chat on the stream anymore altho I didn't modify any settings at all & out of sudden it stopped showing chat on stream, other platforms are working fine but only twitch does this so idk if its on my side or something has to do with twitch itself. OBS is not related to streamlabs. Any issue with their apps or services must be directed to their support. Yeah but this isn't just a Streamlabs issue. This is relating to both Streamlabs as well as OBS. I ask for help there and forth. Surely someone here will have some insight on how to correct this problem as it seems pretty common. Just like the other poster here said, no settings were changed at all. It randomly decided one day that it was just no longer going to correctly display the browser source. Turned out it was an OBS related issue after all.
