There is not a need to know all inputs, tools & techniques and outputs for the exam. It does help if you can identify what process in the question is being described and then identifying the next process. I drew out the below table before I started my exam and used it for a couple of questions but not a lot so if you strapped for studying time it's not a must. The only knowledge area which can be tedious is Human resources which has 3 but once you realize they are in executing it's easy to fill them in. For controlling and monitoring process group there are two new processes Perform Integrated Change Control and Validate Scope. Step 6: Finish off Planning Process group there are two new processes per knowledge area so I knew how many I had to fill out. In general there are no getting around just knowing the sequence for Scope, Time, Cost and Risk.
