How to use wahl trimmer attachments

Before using the ear-nose-brow trimmer, make sure it's turned off and follow these steps to install or remove the trimming heads: first, turn the trimmer head counterclockwise for a quarter-turn and lift it off; then place the new trimmer head on the device and lock it in by turning it clockwise for a quarter-turn. For trimming nose hair, ensure your nasal passages are clean before using the rotary blade/detailer to gently move it in and out of each nostril up to one-quarter inch deep. When trimming ear hair, make sure the outer area doesn't have any wax buildup; hold the ear flat with one hand while carefully inserting the rotary blade/detailer up to one-quarter inch into the outer ear. Be cautious not to insert the device or any other foreign object into your inner ear. For trimming eyebrows, use the rotary blade/detailer to move it slowly and neatly along the edges of the eyebrow area, adjusting its distance from the hairline for precise trimming. When using the eyebrow attachment comb, place it over the reciprocating head to trim and shape your brows; always follow the direction of hair growth when detailing sideburns or mustache with the detailing head. For hard-to-reach areas, use the detailer head and move it slowly through the area until you achieve your desired look. If your trimmer doesn't seem to be taking a charge, check if there's an issue with the outlet current by plugging in another appliance; ensure the outlet isn't connected to a light switch that turns off power when lights are off. Check all connections and make sure the switch on the trimmer is turned off. For cleaning and care instructions, download the Care Instructions from the manufacturer's website. The Pocket Pro Operation Manual also includes instructions on how to remove the battery compartment cover and insert one AA alkaline battery. 1. To assemble the trimmer, first locate the battery compartment and remove any protective covering on the contacts. 2. Take the trimming attachment of your choice, insert one side over the front blade, push the other side until it clicks into place and secure with a small tab at the back. 3. Ensure that both tabs are securely locked in the trimmer before operating. 4. To change between lengths, refer to the provided chart and select the desired length guide based on your animal's type and coat. 5. Trim along the lay of hair for best results, taking into consideration the direction you wish to cut your pet's fur. 6. For optimal performance, keep the trimmer blades clean by rinsing with water after each use and allowing it to dry completely before storing. 7. To ensure precise cuts, always attach clipper guards according to the manufacturer's guidelines, which typically correspond to specific inch measurements on the guard. 8. Plug out plug from wall outlet. SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS ONLY FOR HOUSEHOLD USE 2. Make trimmer ready for charging. Connect it to recharging transformer and let it charge overnight before first use. 3. Make sure trimmer is in "off-zero" mode when plugging charger into the wall outlet. 4. Plug recharger into any convenient electrical outlet with correct voltage. 5. When you run low, plug trimmer into recharger and plug into outlet for best performance next time. 6. Recharge battery every month by letting it run until it stops working, switch to "off-zero" position and recharge fully overnight. Then, using the trimmer in an upward motion, start trimming under the chin with short, outward strokes. Blend the entire jawline before moving on to other areas. To define your mustache, hold the trimmer vertically and begin trimming from top to bottom. Use progressively closer settings for the desired look and length. For a tapered effect, set the guide comb at a medium length and start in the middle of your mustache, following the lip line with short upward strokes. Finish by creating a definitive line at the bottom. Use the trimmer head without attachments to tidy up stray hairs. To trim arm and leg hair, simply glide the trimmer over the area until you reach your desired length. For chest and stomach hair, use the same method, starting with a longer setting and gradually decreasing it for shorter lengths. The shaver head is ideal for cleaning up in and around facial hair. When trimming nose or ear hair, start by making sure the nasal passages or outer ear areas are clean. Use the rotary head to carefully trim hairs without inserting any foreign objects into the inner ear. For stray eyebrow hairs, use the detailer to neatly trim them, adjusting the distance from your eyebrows for the desired length. Attachments are versatile tools for styling beards, achieving a close shave, and defining facial hair. To get the desired look, simply follow the direction of your hair growth when using attachments, and go against it to achieve a closer trim around the face. When it comes to disposing of used batteries, remember that nickel-cadmium (Ni-Cd) batteries must be recycled or disposed of properly. Wahl is committed to preserving our environment by participating in an industry program that collects and recycles these batteries at the end of their life cycle. To recycle your Ni-Cd batteries, call 1-800-8-BATTERY for information on recycling centers in your area. Under normal use, rechargeable nickel-cadmium batteries can last up to five years before needing replacement. When they reach the end of their life, remove and recycle them properly or dispose of them through an authorized Wahl service location. To troubleshoot any issues with your trimmer not taking a charge, check the outlet current, ensure proper connections, and make sure the switch is turned off. Additionally, if you notice your blades are stuck together due to dried oil, simply turn on the unit and manually pinch or push the blades apart. For optimal performance and blade longevity, apply one to two drops of Wahl Clipper Oil to the blades once a month. Wahl trimmer blades require special care. Start by wiping off any excess oil with a soft cloth to avoid over-oiling, which can cause damage if the liquid seeps back into the motor.
