For a soft reset, press and hold the Alt, Right-Shift, and Backspace/Delete keys. To restore your BlackBerry to its original factory settings, go to Options > Security Settings > Security Wipe. 1 Open the battery cover on the back of the BlackBerry. Remove the battery from the phone. You can perform a hard reset on the BlackBerry Z10 by pressing and holding the Power button on the top of the phone for about 10 seconds. 2 Reinsert the battery after a few seconds. To be on the safe side, wait for up to 30 seconds and then reinsert the battery into the back of the phone. Advertisement 3 Close the battery cover. The device boasts a compact size, measuring 115 x 66 x 10.5 mm, weighing 130 grams, and featuring a 2.8-inch screen with a resolution of ~32.0% screen-to-body ratio.Powered by a 1.2 GHz processor, the phone is equipped with 768 MB RAM and an internal memory of 8 GB, allowing users to enjoy seamless performance.
