With iLovePDF, you can choose between normal conversion or OCR. Without OCR the tool is extremely accurate, but if you wanted even more accuracy then convert using OCR. This will scan the document and its images to create readable text from the original content.Upload your file to the free PDF to Word converter.Choose between normal conversion or OCR. Click Convert to Word to download your converted Word file.Go to your Google Drive.> New > File Upload and upload your Word file.When the file has uploaded to your Google Drive, right click and select Open with > Google Docs.Are you trying to put a PDF into Google Docs instead of converting? If you have important information that you want to share inside of your Doc, use this method to include PDF pages as images. Go to the PDF to JPG tool.Upload the PDF from your computer, Google Drive, or Dropbox.Select Page to JPG to extract every page of the PDF or Extract Images to convert all images embedded in the PDF into JPG.Click Convert to JPG.Click Download JPG images to save the files to your local storage, upload them to the cloud platforms, or download using a QR code and link.Open your Google Doc and go to Insert > Image > Upload from computer.Find the JPG files you just downloaded.Highlight the files you want to add to your Google Doc and select Open.You can also upload a PDF to your Google Doc using Google Drive.
