George RR Martin's Fire & Blood 2 is still a work in progress despite the release of his other projects. The author has already started writing the second volume but has not given a specific timeline for its completion. After finishing A Dream of Spring and another Dunk & Egg short, he will focus on Fire & Blood 2. However, with House of the Dragon out now, it's possible that Martin could finish the book ahead of schedule, as he has already written a significant portion of it. According to Martin, his writing plan includes completing Winds of Winter, followed by A Dream of Spring and then the second part of Fire & Blood. He also mentioned that he is working on other projects such as a coffee table book with Elio Garcia and Linda Antonsson, an illustrated history of House Targaryen titled The Rise of the Dragon, and a Who's Who in Westeros. Martin has given updates on his writing schedule, stating that after releasing A Dream of Spring, he will write another Dunk & Egg short before focusing on Fire & Blood 2. However, with some projects already underway, it is possible that he could finish Fire & Blood 2 ahead of the other books. The Winds of Winter, the sixth novel in George R.R. Martin's A Song of Ice and Fire series, has been in the making for 13 years and counting. While the book remains his primary focus, Martin is also working on a sequel to his Targaryen history book, Fire & Blood. Martin recently discussed his writing process in a blog post, stating that "writing came hard" over the past year. He mentioned producing new pages on both The Winds of Winter and the upcoming Blood & Fire sequel, but expressed disappointment at not being able to write more. Fire & Blood is planned as a two-volume set, covering Westeros' history from Aegon's Conquest to Robert's Rebellion. The book will span around 150 years, with 10 Targaryen kings featured, including notable figures such as Baelor the Blessed and Daeron II. Additionally, Martin hinted at the revelation of the bond between dragons and their riders in Fire & Blood, which will also be explored in more detail in The Winds of Winter and A Dream of Spring. In Fire & Blood, King Jaehaerys the Conciliator had a close friend renowned for his studies on dragons and the occult. This scholar's work would later be deemed blasphemous by a king. To learn about this history, The World of Ice and Fire is a great resource, but it only provides an overview. Fire & Blood hints at revealing more information about historical figures who shaped the Seven Kingdoms. Unfortunately, there is no release date for Blood & Fire as George R.R. Martin is still working on the book. He plans to release it after The Winds of Winter. Martin has been working on his fantasy series 'A Song of Ice and Fire' since 1996, with only two volumes left before its conclusion. His upcoming novel 'The Winds of Winter' has faced immense pressure from fans to be published, which he recently addressed in a note on Not A Blog. He is struggling to balance the writing process due to his workload on other TV projects, including 'Dark Winds' and 'The Hedge Knight'. Martin expressed frustration about the lack of progress on 'The Winds of Winter', stating that he would have liked to produce more pages but was hindered by external factors. He also mentioned the loss of his friend Howard Waldrop and how it affected his writing. In a recent panel interview, Martin admitted that if he could change one thing in his books, it would be to have them finished already. This comes as 'House of the Dragon' continues to dominate screens, with many fans eager for more information about the series. George R.R. Martin's previous publication, 'Fire and Blood', was a 736-page history of House Targaryen that started from Aegon III. Although he intends to publish its sequel, 'Fire and Blood 2', fans are still waiting for the conclusion of 'A Song of Ice and Fire' with 'The Winds of Winter' and 'A Dream of Spring'. Martin has revealed that 'Fire and Blood 2' is planned out but cannot be published until after the completion of 'ASOIAF'. George RR Martin says he's got plenty on his plate before tackling the second volume of Fire and Blood. He plans to finish The Winds of Winter next year, followed by a break to write the fourth Dunk and Egg novella. After that, he'll start working on A Dream of Spring, the final book in the A Song of Ice and Fire series. Only then will he begin writing another Dunk and Egg story, before finally getting back to Fire and Blood 2. Considering his slow pace in recent years, it seems like Fire and Blood 2 might not arrive until up to a decade from now, possibly even later than that if Martin sticks to his own schedule for The Winds of Winter.
