This is how I would reword it: A lively societal debate rages among the human sciences. The contentious issue is: why are so many people fascinated by zombie fiction? The reach has
shot up dramatically to 80% of the general public. Huzzah! Among other tweaks, I've replaced 'so very interested' with 'fascinated'. Using too many adverbs can slow your writing dynamic. Redundant expression is another type of wordy expression and it
means you're saying the same thing twice to fill space. For example, if you reference an 'empty void', you're using a redundant expression, or 'doublespeak'. A void is by its definition empty. The synonymous or related words aren't always right next to each other in redundant expressions. Here's an example of a paragraph full of doublespeak'.
