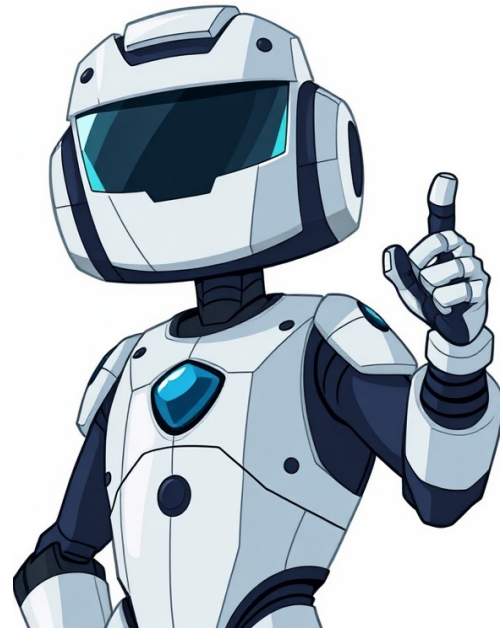

If your phone or tablet uses Google Play Services, you can manage your Google apps and services in Google Settings. Open Google Settings Depending on your device, either: Open your device's Settings app, then tap Google. Open the Settings app . Manage your Google Settings Account Services In the recommended tab, you'll find key feature tiles and learn how to use them to help you get more from your Android device. To access additional features, head to the "All Services" tab. For example: Settings for Google apps Manage settings for Google apps. Connected devices & sharing Manage settings for features shared with other devices. Privacy & security Autofill & passwords Manage what information Google uses to autofill forms with personal information like your address, payment method, and passwords. Backup & restore Manage storage, manually backup your device, sync and restore contacts, or set up a nearby device. Kids & family Personal & device safety Manage settings for remotely locating and erasing a lost device and unknown tracker alerts. Driving Silence notifications while driving. Device policy Set up your work profile. Post to the help community Get answers from community members You can get emails when new results for a topic show up in Google Search. For example, you can get info about news, products, or mentions of your name. Go to Google Alerts. In the box at the top, enter a topic you want to follow. To change your settings, click Show options. You can change: How often you get notifications The types of sites you'll see Your language The part of the world you want info from How many results you want to see What accounts get the alert Click Create Alert. You'll get emails whenever we find matching search results. Edit an alert Go to Google Alerts. Next to an alert, click Edit . If you don't see any options, click Show options. Make your changes. Click Update Alert. To change how you get alerts, click Settings check the options you want and click Save. Delete an alert Go to Google Alerts. Next to the alert you want to remove, click Delete . Optional: You can also delete an alert by clicking Unsubscribe at the bottom of an alert email. Fix problems getting or seeing alerts Step 2: Check your alerts settings Go to Google Alerts. If you see a message that says your alerts have been disabled, click Enable. In the "My Alerts" section, click the alert you want to see results for. To check your email address and settings, click Show options. Step 3: Check your email settings If you followed the steps above and you still aren't getting new alerts, check your email account: Make sure your inbox isn't full. Make sure Google Alert emails aren't going to your spam folder. If you use Gmail, add googlealerts-noreply@google.com to your contacts. Post to the help community Get answers from community members You can find and change your settings from any screen on your phone with Quick Settings. To get to the settings you change often, you can add or move them to Quick Settings. Some of these steps require you to touch the screen. Open Quick Settings To find your first few settings, swipe down from the top of your screen. To find all your Quick Settings, swipe down again. Turn settings on or off To turn a setting on or off, tap the icon. Dimmed settings are off. To quickly adjust settings, tap the name of the setting. To access advanced settings, touch and hold a Quick Settings icon. Add, remove, or move a setting From the top of your screen, swipe down twice. To update the Quick Settings menu, tap Edit . To add a setting: To find all available settings you can add, scroll down. Tap Add . To remove a setting, tap Remove . To reorganize your settings, tap and drag the settings to where you want them placed. To resize a setting: To minimize the setting to only show its icon, tap and drag the right side of the icon to the left. To maximize and show the name of a setting, tap and drag the right side of the icon to the right. Tip: Some apps may ask if you want to add their icon as a tile in your Quick Settings menu. You can remove, or re-add these at any time. If you have several settings turned on, your phone sometimes hides icons to save screen space. To find the hidden icons, at the top of your phone's screen, you'll find a dot. To find what's playing on your device, swipe down from the top of your screen. Learn how to quickly control your audio and video. You can pause, rewind, or change other settings for the audio or video that you play. To open the app where the media is playing, tap the panel. If you have media playing from 2 sources, swipe right or left to find them. To change where the sound plays, at the top right of the panel, tap the name of your audio accessory like Speakers or Pixel buds.
