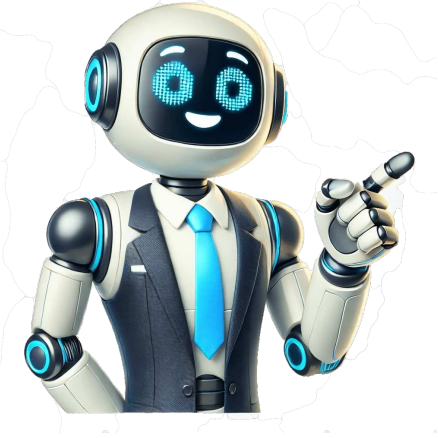

To troubleshoot the Kwikset powerbolt 2, you must come to know the pain points of it. Changing the code seems pretty simle, as it takes a few steps to finish. But the hack is with detcting the key problem: Kwikset powerbolt 2 change code

Apart from it, I have published another article on Kwikset Powerbolt 2 Troubleshooting which will take you to the every possible solution that you might have while using it. If you need to change the code on your Kwikset lock, it’s easy to do. Just follow these simle steps:

1. Find the small hole on the edge of the lock face. This is where you’ll insert the reset tool that comes with your lock.
2. Insert the reset tool and turn it clockwise until you hear a click. Keep turning until the reset tool pops out.
3. Remove the old battery from the back of the lock and insert a new one. Make sure it’s inserted in the correct direction so that the plus (+) side is facing up.
4. Enter your new code by pressing each number in sequence, then press “Enter.” The LED light will blink green to indicate that your new code has been accepted.

If you need to change the code on your Kwikset Powerbolt 2, it’s a pretty simle process. Just follow these steps and you’ll be done in no time:

1. Start by removing the battery cover from the back of the unit. This will expose the batteries and the keypad. Note: The locking mechanism should be at unlocked position unless it won’t work!
2. Locate the small black button above the keypad (it’s labeled “PROG”). Press and hold this buton for about 5 seconds until you see the red LED light above the button start flashing.
3. Enter your 4-10 digit codes on the keypad, then press and release the “PROG” button again. Note: if you are resetting the master code then you will enter default codes 0-0-0-0. The red LED should stop flashing, indicating that your new code has been successfully programmed into the unit.
4. Replace the battery cover and test out your new code!

If you need to change the code on your Kwikset lock after a Kwikset smart lock reset, there are a few steps you’ll need to follow. First, locate the small button on the inside of the door knob. This is usually located near the bottom of the knob. Once you’ve found it, press and hold it for a few seconds. Next, use the key that came with your lock to turn it to the “unlock” position. Finally, enter your new code into the keypad and press “enter.” There are a few possible reasons why the Kwikset powerbolt 2 won’t program, and they are:

- Using the incorrect master code: Incorrect master code won’t allow you to open the door, it is pretty obvious. Hence, you need to reset it
- Key inserting timeout: The programming process delay more then 10 seconds is another reason for not working issue. Here you need to re-do it again within 10 seconds.
- Following wrong programming process: We have already talked about how to use key for the powerbolt keypad. If you have done anything inappropriate, then this will lead you to the back door. If you need to reprogram your Kwikset Powerbolt, there are a few things you’ll need to do. First, you’ll need to find the “Learn” button on the back of the unit. Once you’ve found that, press and hold it for around 20 seconds until the LED light on the front of the unit starts blinking. After that, you’ll need to enter your four-digit code (which can be found in your user manual). Here the default master code is 0-0-0-0 4 digit code, which you will change and set your own. Once you’ve done that, simply press the “Lock” button on the front of the unit and your new code will be set!

If you want to ensure the hard code for the master lock then set it up to 10 digits. Since, you can set it up from 4 to 10 digits

If you forget your Mastercode on your Powerbolt 2, there are a few things that you can do in order to try and remember it. The first thing that you should do is try and recall where you may have written it down. This could be in a notebook, on a sticky note, or even in the manual that came with the Powerbolt 2. If you cannot find it anywhere, the next best thing to do is to reset the code back to the factory default code. To do this, simply press and hold the “Program” button for approximately 20 seconds until the LED light blinks twice. Finally, release the button and enter in your new 4-8 digit code. Steps to change your access code to a new code. This will also remove any previous codes stored in the Powerbolt’s memory.

1. Manually put the bolt in the extended (lock) position. Press the PROGRAM button once, enter your new 4 - 8 digit code and then press the LOCK button.
2. Press the PROGRAM button twice, enter the same or a new code and then press the LOCK button once.

If your old code still remains in the unit, you will need to perform a hard reset of the unit. To perform a hard reset of the unit, remove all four batteries and leave them out for 1 hour. After the hour has passed, you may re-enter the batteries.Steps to re-keying Smart Key units (Note: You must have your Functioning Key and Learn Tool for this to work).

1. Insert functioning key & turn 1/4 turn clockwise.
2. Insert & remove the SmartKey learn tool. Remove functioning key.
3. Insert new key & turn 1/2 turn counter-clockwise. Done.

Your lock is now re-keyed!”

If you did not receive any keys with the #####ARTICLETo program your Kwikset Powerbolt 2, first reset the lock by keeping the door open and unlocked. Press the master code 0000, then complete these steps: Keep the door open and unlocked, then press to test if it can lock the door. Test the default user code, inserting 1234 and pressing until the door unlocks. Now, to reset the Kwikset default master code for powerbolt 2, ensure the door is open and unlocked, include the default master code 0000, and press the lock button. You will hear one beep. Press number 7 and then press the lock button again, hearing another beep. Enter a 4- to 10-digit code and press the lock button. If successful, the lock will beep twice, and the keypad will flash green.

The SmartCode 888 and other Kwikset models offer various user code management options, making it easy to grant access to family members and trusted guests. To begin, ensure the door is open and press the Program button once, then enter a unique user code between 4 and 8 digits, depending on your smart home system. Pressing the Lock button will complete the process, and the lock will beep once with a green flash if successful. However, if the code is incorrect or duplicate, the lock will flash red three times with three beeps. #####ARTICLE
