It may be kind of confusing because some gods were the same, but spelled differently in different places. Of the 34 I listed below, some can be the same as well, but I am very confident that most are not. It is also interesting to note that most larger cities had numerous gods (polytheans). For example, the city of Athens had so many gods / gods (Acts 17:16), who actually made an edole - for the unknown God-â € (Acts 17:23), only in case they lost any! (Paul used this opportunity to tell them about the only true God of all creation.) Who was there among all the gods of these nations that my parents totally destroyed, that could deliver their people from my hand, may your God be able to deliver you from my hand? Now, do not let Ezequias deceive you, nor persuade him in this way, still do not believe in him: Because no God of any nation or kingdom has been able to deliver his people out of his hand, and Out of my parents' hand: The less your God would free you from my hand? And his servants speak even more against the Lord God, and against His servant Hezekiah. He also wrote letters to rails in the Lord God of Israel, and speak against him, saying, as the gods of the nations of other lands did not give His people out of the hand, no God of Hezekiah delivers His people out of my hand. So, they cried in a loud voice in the speech of the Jews to the people of JerusalÂ € m that were on the wall, to curl them and bother them; that they can take the city. And they speak against the God of Jerusal, as against the gods of the people of the earth, who were the work of man's hands.
