The National History Bee is an annual history quiz competition open to students aged 19 years or younger who are enrolled in primary, secondary, or have graduated within the past five months. This competition includes Elementary and Middle School divisions, as well as Varsity and Junior Varsity levels for high school students. To compete, students must take the Online Regional Qualifying Exam (ORQE), which places them into a division according to their grade level and then qualify for Regional Finals.The National History Bee is held at the regional and national levels in a buzzer-based format where students answer paragraph-length questions on various historical topics. The top half of the preliminary round qualifies for the National Championships, which features six preliminary rounds and three playoff stages to determine the National Champion. This competition awards points based on correct answers and provides a challenging trivia experience.Recent history bee finals to take place at various times, individual standings available for 2023 international history olympiad The final overall individual standings from the 2022 International History Olympiad can be found here, but unfortunately collegiate division results are not avaiable . Connor Huey is the Collegiate Division Overall Champion , however.
