Playa la entrega ubicada en la Bahía de Santa cruz es una de las playas más bonitas de toda la bahía y sin duda de todas las Bahías de Huatulco, por lo mismo también es la preferida entre los visitantes tanto extranjeros como nacionales y los lugareños. Una maravilla de la naturaleza en donde se pueden realizar diferentes actividades como el snorkell, paseo en lancha, moto acuática, paseo en la banana, etc. También cuenta con una gran variedad de palapas restaurantes para degustar de los mariscos de la región. Asimismo para recordar los momentos en playa la entrega los lugareños te ofrecen el servicio de fotografía y video visitando el arrecife de coral donde puedes encontrar diversas especies de peces (peces de colores) y con un poco de suerte el pez globo en su hábit. Además, también tienes la fortuna de observar el sendero submarino (la cueva) con colorido en las rocas extraordinario, y animales de oscuridad como los murciélagos e insectos, toda una sensación de adrenalina y sorpresa. Las formas de acceder son distintas: Primero, tomar un taxi en el centro de la Bahía y pedirle que te lleve directo a playa la entrega. (son aproximadamente 10 a 15 min). Por otro lado si llevas transporte propio del parque central te diriges por el Boulevard Chahue hasta llegar a tienda Elektra, giras a la derecha llegas a Santa Cruz y te topas con el letrero donde dice "playa la entrega" y sigues la ruta directo hasta tu destino. De manera similar el servicio de transporte tanto autobús como taxi no cuenta con ruta colectivo hasta playa la entrega, solamente llega hasta la bahía de santa Cruz. Sin duda playa la entrega es una buena opción para niños y grandes, por sus tranquilas aguas sin mucha marea, un color verdoso cristalino lo hace una de las favoritas de la zona. Por otro lado en cuestiones de hotelería podemos encontrar hoteles cerca de la playa en Bahía de santa Cruz, o en centro de las bahías de Huatulco. Además con diferentes precios y promociones, hay opciones al gusto del público, es cuestión de buscar la que mejor se adecue a sus intereses. La Entrega lies toward the outer edge of Bahía de Santa Cruz, a five-minute motorboat trip or 2.5km walk/drive along a bendy road from Santa Cruz. This 300m beach, backed by a line of seafood palapas, can get busy, but it has decent (if sometimes crowded) snorkeling on a coral plate from which boats are cordoned off. Gear is available at Renta de Snorkel Vicente on the beach's northern end. 'La Entrega' means 'The Delivery': in 1831 Mexican independence hero Vicente Guerrero was handed over here to his political enemies by a Genoese sea captain. Guerrero was then taken to Cuilapan near Oaxaca and shot.
