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Up bow down bow

Whether people are are wearing them seriously or ironically, bow ties are making a come-back. Gone are the days where they were only associated with academics. If you're looking to channel your inner Bill Nye and rock a bow tie, you'll need to learn how to tie one. Unfortunately trial and error can be stressful. Follow these step-by-step instructions and wait for the compliments to come pouring in. That's a way better solution compared to giving yourself hand cramps from many failed attempts. 1. The Un-tied Bow TieMeasuring 3" to 3.5" the large "Butterfly" bow tie is for the larger face/neck individual or someone purposefully looking to draw attention. The "Batwing" bow tie goes the other way with a height of roughly 1.5" to 2". It's slicker and will still draw attention to the wearer. For many people, the bow saw has just such an attraction; to my eye, even its shape looks tried-and-true, as handsome as it is utilitarian.The bow saw is of ancient design; the hacksaw and coping saws are its diminutive and distant contemporary cousins. More than likely, the bow saw was devised to utilize to best advantage a small amount of an expensive material, such as iron and, later, steel. Thus, the substantial wooden elements of the saw provide a framework for holding the metal blade in tension. A woodsman or toolmaker could easily shape these of beech, birch, cherry, or other hardwood, and have to purchase only the long, thin metal blade.The ends of the blade attach to the cheeks, as the wooden members perpendicular to the blade are called. Running parallel to the blade across the center of the bow saw is a stretcher. Atop the cheeks is a cord and winding stick that is turned to tighten or loosen the blade. The closer the upper ends of the cheeks are drawn together, the tighter becomes the tension on the blade.The bow saw can be used for a variety of tasks, both on site and in the shop. In some European countries, the bow saw is a standard woodworker's tool; in others it is rarely found in the workshop but is often used in the forest. The explanation is more a matter of tradition than of function.As with any tool, the bow saw takes a bit of practice to master. The larger models require two hands (some users prefer a two-handed grip that distantly resembles that used on a golf-club handle, others like a front-and-back grip similar to that used when hacksawing). A well-balanced smaller bow saw can be comfortably used one-handed. The blade length may range from as little as 15 to as much as 40 inches.The bow saw is sometimes called a frame saw, although some frame saws are not bow saws. The broader category of frame saws includes those that have two blades (one each at the top and bottom, flanking a wooden stretcher) and some with single blades at the center. Some frame saws have larger blades and are intended for cutoff work; others have thinner blades that can be turned in the frame so that the tool can be used like an oversized coping or fretsaw.Not everyone needs a bow saw, of course, but if looks are part of the appeal tools have for you, few tools are more impressive than a handsome bow saw. Leave the bowing to the royals, unless you're at the gym. The good morning—an exercise in which you position a barbell across your upper back and bend forward at your hips as if you're bowing—blasts your glutes, hamstrings, lower back, and core. Select a length of ribbon that will be long enough for the size of bow you want to create. In general, ribbon that is at least a foot long is recommended for an attractive bow, but you can make something larger for more impact too if you wish. Next, find the center of the length of ribbon. Create two evenly sized loops on either side of the center, leaving some excess ribbon hanging down as tails. Some people refer to this as forming bunny ears in the ribbon. Debbie Colgrove Cross one loop over the other to create an X shape. Then, fold that loop behind the other one, and bring it back forward through the opening in the center. Make sure that you are firmly holding the other loop during this process. Finally, pull on both loops to form a knot. Debbie Colgrove Pull the ribbon tails to shorten the loops and adjust the size of the bow while holding onto the center knot. Likewise, pull the ribbon loops to make them larger and to tighten the knot. Keep adjusting until the proportions of loops versus tails are according to your preference. If you still do not like the look of your bow, you can always pull on a tail until the center knot comes loose and start the process over. You might want to do this if your loops ended up off center, and you can't seem to get the proportions even. Then, if necessary twist the center knot, loops, and tails of the ribbon, so the right side (the side with the best color and/or pattern) faces outward. Finally, smooth the bow, so it lies flat. If you wish, you can cut an angle or a V shape into the edges of the tails for a more refined look. You also can trim some length off of the tails if you decide they are too long for your taste.
